THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

Indiana College Core

- Dual credit classes: Colleges can accept it however they want.
- Taking a plan of 30+ set college classes (mostly junior/senior year) guarantees that those credits are taken at college as the classes that they are.
- Weighted grades (including these) WILL affect GPA and class rank.
- Academic kids going to college want to look at this as an option.
- Working with COSMOS and VU to get all the courses needed for our students to get this.

- Most of the classes are already part of their schedule; they just take the dual credit version (i.e. US History, 3rd science, Trig/PreCal, English 12)
- Students basically complete their freshman year of college in high school and enter college as a sophomore
- Benefits: Can save you lots of money, can help them finish college a semester or year early (depending on the school/their major), can pick classes and dorms earlier, can allow them to start their major classes earlier
- Students will take most of these during junior/senior year but it is nice to get Music Appreciation out of the way during 10th grade, if they can

THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

Weighted Grades

- When a grade is "worth" more because it is a harder class.
- Taking more weighted classes can raise your GPA if you do well in the course.
- Weighted grades started with the Class of 2026.
- If wanting to compete for Valedictorian or Salutatorian or Top 10, then will want to take dual credit options if they can.
- Classes weighted +.5=CTE pathway classes (Ag, Engineering, Healthcare, Teaching, Culinary)
- Classes weighted +1=ICC-eligible courses (basically English, Math, Science, Social Studies)
- Always challenge yourself with things you are good at.**
