Course Request for 7th/8th Grade Course Directions for Homeroom Teachers:

Please read these as the students fill them out:

- Write your last name.
- Write your first name.
- Read the paragraph to them.
- CTE Pathway: Only check ONE. Mark the ONE you are MOST interested in. This will NOT assign you to anything put pick what interests you the most:
 - o Ag Power–This is welding.
 - o Animal Science-This is learning all about animals.
 - Construction—This is where you build things out of wood.
 - o Business–This is where you learn how to run a business.
 - o Ed Prof–This is about learning about how to be a teacher.
 - o Health Science-This covers the medical field.
 - Culinary–This is a cooking class.
 - Civic Arts: Art–This is drawing and sculpture.
 - o Civic Arts: Band-This is for students who play instruments and want to be in the band.
 - o Civic Arts: Choir–This is for students who like to sing.
 - o Engineering–This is for students who like to figure out things; need to be good at math.
- Career Choice: If you had to decide TODAY, based on all you know, what job would you want to have as an adult.
- Post-HS: If you had to decide TODAY, what would you do when you leave OHS? Would you go to a
 2-year college, would you go to a 4-year college, would you go to a technical school or trade school
 (like cosmetology school or school to be a mechanic or other trade), would you go into the military, or
 would you go straight into the workforce by getting a job? Check ONE.
- Diploma Track: Pick the diploma track, based on what you usually do in school, you are planning to get. If you get mostly Cs, Ds, Fs then you will pick Core 40. If you get mostly As and Bs, you will pick AHD. If you get As, Bs and some Cs AND plan to go to college, pick AHD but you will need to be working on your grades starting now to accomplish this!
- Your Schedule: These are the classes you will have next year—Lang Arts, Science, Social Studies, (7th grade) PE/Health or (8th grade) Exploring College and Careers/Basic Skills, and 4 rotation electives.
 We do not know what the options will be for the rotation electives or if there will be a choice like there was this year; we will know more in late-April/early-May.
- Your Selection Courses: Your math has been selected already based on a recommendation by your math teacher based on your performance and grasp on content so far this year. If you have questions, ask your math teacher during class this week. Make sure you read all the information about what happens with them. MOST students will take the regular Math 7/8 course.
- Your Selection Courses: Pick your elective course option. If you pick Band/Choir/FFA, you will have some days with that course and some days as SH.
