

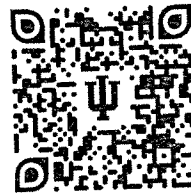


Each optional session is designed to help you through the enrollment process. Sessions will cover different topics like preparing for **class registration** and understanding your **financial aid**.

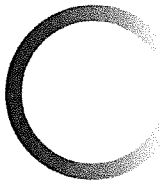
Set up your IU account

- If you run into technical issues with your account, contact the IT Help Desk: helpdesk@ius.edu | (812) 941-2447



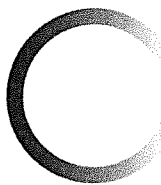
Submit scholarship application and FAFSA

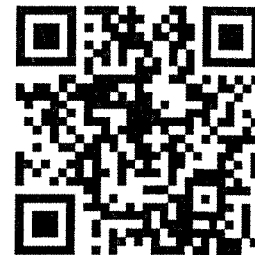
Meet with an advisor to register for classes
