Highlights include a Statehouse tour, mock bill activity, speakers and other educational activities. Students may have the opportunity to see the Indiana Legislature in action and meet their legislator. **The program is open to high school students.** Page day will be held on January 24, 2024 or February 20, 2024.



SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: February 16, 2024

Each year Orange County REMC awards up to 6 scholarships, which are funded by the Operation Round Up program. To apply for one of the \$750 scholarships, students must graduate from Paoli, Springs Valley, Orleans, Mitchell, Crawford or West Washington whose parents/guardians are members of Orange County REMC.



INDIANA YOUTH TOUR

Deadline: March 1, 2024

During the month of June, Indiana's electric cooperatives sponsor an unforgettable educational adventure to Washington D.C., **for high school seniors-to-be whose parents/guardians are Orange County REMC members.** This seven day trip on June 16-23 includes visits with Indiana's congressional leaders on Capitol Hill and a youth event with student delegates across the country.



CAMP KILOWATT

Deadline: March 1, 2024

A fun and unique camp experience for from 6th grade students (entering 7th grade in the fall of 2024) whose parents/guardians are Orange County REMC members. The camp takes place on June 5-8 and gives kids a chance to learn about energy while making new friends and enjoying activities and games. This three-day camp includes horseback riding, electric cooperative education, rocking climbing, swimming, and much more.

Deadline: March 24, 2024

Indiana **K-12 students** are invited to enter Cooperative Calendar of Student Art Contest for a chance to illustrate an award-winning wall calendar. Winners will have their artwork displayed at the annual Hoosier Salon exhibition.

That's why each year we assist our young members in their pursuit of higher education by awarding scholarships to our graduating seniors.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the scholarship, the following provisions must be met:

- An applicant's parents, legal guardian, or primary relative must be a member of Orange County REMC participating in Operation Round Up when the scholarship application is judged.
- > Applicants must graduate by the end of June 2024.
- Applicants must be accepted into an accredited Indiana College or Indiana Trade School.
- The scholarship recipient must: not have previously attended college or hold incoming freshman status.
- > Applicants are to submit the following:
 - > An essay
 - > Up to three letters of recommendation
 - A list of extracurricular activities
 - Verification of your grade point average for the current school year, and at least one prior year







ELIGIBILITY

Indiana public, private or home-schooled students in kindergarten through 12th grade during the 2023-24 school year are eligible to enter the contest.

DETAILS AND DEADLINE

A complete set of rules and required entry forms are available at **indianaconnection.org/for-youth/art-contest**. Artwork must be received by March 29, 2024.

PRIZES

A first-place artist will be selected for each grade, K-12, and will receive \$200. The artwork of each grade level winner will also illustrate either the cover or a month of the calendar. Additional artists will earn honorable mention awards and will receive \$75. Their artwork will appear in a special section of the calendar. An "artist of the year" will be selected from among the first place winners and will receive an additional \$100.
