Who are we?

We are a 75-year old family owned manufacturing company that produces engineered component parts from sheet metal for the appliance, HVAC, automotive, and electrical industries. Our raw material is generally coiled steel or sheet. We process this material in machines called stamping presses using specialized tooling called stamping dies. Material is advanced through the stamping die from station to station where work is done at each station and at the final station a completed component part is ejected from the die.

We produce component parts that are generally in the medium to high-volume range. We are typically looking to produce component parts that fall within 50,000 and 10,000,000 pieces per year. We currently operate 7-days per week with a 1st, 2nd and weekend shifts.
